

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

24- KEVIN MULVEY, RHP

Last Start: Got a loss Wednesday, July 9 at Charlotte in Game One of a doubleheader...his line: 4.2 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO...his last win came May 29 vs. Charlotte...was 2-1 with a 1.16 ERA after his first four starts (23.1 IP, 20 H, 3 ER, 7 BB, 25 SO)...is 1-7 with a 4.73 ERA in his last 14 starts (70.1 IP, 77 H, 37 ER, 26 BB, 55 SO).

2008 Season: Mulvey makes his 19th start of the season...his May 29 win over Charlotte was his first since April 17 (7 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 0 BB, 9 SO)...**counting the Pacific Coast League playoffs last year, Mulvey did not allow a run the first 22.1 innings he pitched in Triple A** ...was 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA in 3 relief appearances for the Twins during Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invite (6.0 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 0 BB, 4 SO)...was traded to the Twins from the Mets with RHP Philip Humber, RHP Deolis Guerra and OF Carlos Gomez in exchange for LHP Johan Santana on February 2, 2008...was rated the Mets #4 prospect by *Baseball America* during the offseason.

2007 In Review: Named the Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year...spent the majority of the season with the Mets Double A affiliate Binghamton going 11-10 with a 3.32 ERA...finished 3rd in the Eastern League in ERA...selected to pitch in the Eastern League All Star Game...pitched in the Futures Game in San Francisco on July 8 replacing Matt Garza on the Team USA roster...promoted to Triple A New Orleans on August 31 and won his only regular season start for the Zephyrs.

Career: The 23-year-old was selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2006 draft...was the Mets 1st pick of the draft...signed with the Mets August 9 and made his pro debut August 19, 2006...the New Jersey-native enjoyed a three-year career at Villanova...was named 2nd Team All Big East in 2006.

TOMORROW'S STARTING PITCHER

53- BRIAN DUENSING, LHP

Last Start: Got the loss Sunday, July 13 in Durham in the Wings 9-3 loss...was working on one day less rest than normal after also starting on July 9...his line: 4 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 4 SO...has lost five of last seven starts...26 of the 66 runs he has allowed this season have come in the 1st inning.

2008 Season: Duensing makes his 21st start of the season... went eight shutout innings June 4 in Buffalo (8 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 SO) although he ended up with a no-decision in the Wings 8-7, 10 inning loss...followed that up with seven shutout innings in a win June 9 at Lehigh Valley giving him 15 straight shutout innings...was 0-0 with a 19.29 ERA in 2 relief appearances for the Twins during Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invite (2.1 IP, 5 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 5 BB, 2 SO)...comes into the season rated the Twins #8 Minor League prospect by *Baseball America* magazine.
